

AMEND 2018 APPORTIONMENT REPORT
RESOLUTION 20-2018

WHEREAS, MCL 211.37 as amended, requires the County Board of Commissioners at their October session, to apportion the amount of property taxes to be raised by the various taxing jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, the attached Apportionment Report contains a summary of the requests for millages to be levied via resolution No. 19-2018 on October 16, 2018; and

WHEREAS, an amendment to the tax spread is required which reflects a voted millage increase on November 6, 2018 for St. Joseph County: Commission on Aging Millage Proposition 0.7500 Mill; and

WHEREAS, an amendment to the tax spread is also required which reflects a voted millage increase on November 6, 2018 for White Pigeon Township: Road Improvement Millage Proposition 0.7500 Mill; and

WHEREAS, an amendment to the tax spread is also required which reflects a voted millage increase on November 6, 2018 for White Pigeon Township: Emergency Services Millage Proposition 0.7500 Mill; and

WHEREAS, an amendment to the tax spread is also required which reflects a voted millage increase on November 6, 2018 for Nottawa Community Schools: Sinking Fund Millage Proposition 1.5000 Mill; and

WHEREAS, MCL 207.12, as amended, requires the Director of the County Tax Equalization Department to make and submit to the Department of Treasury, State Tax Commission, a detailed report of such actions by the County Board on a form prescribed by the Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the St. Joseph County Board of Commissioners approves the attached summary of millage requests by the various taxing jurisdictions and further authorizes the St. Joseph County Equalization Director to certify such forms and submit them as required by law to the appropriate departments.

It was moved by Commissioner Balog and seconded by Commissioner Pangle to adopt the resolution to amend the 2018 apportionment report. Motion carried 3-0 upon roll call vote.
