1. **DIVORCE:** The marriage between the parties is dissolved and a divorce granted.

The custodial parent shall promptly notify the Friend of the Court and the other parent in writing whenever the child(ren) is/are moved to any new address. In addition, a parent whose custody or parenting time is governed by this Order, shall not change the legal residence of the child except in compliance with MCL 722.31.

2f. **Tax Exemptions:** The Wife Husband has the right to claim the minor child(ren) of the parties for State and Federal income tax purposes; **OR** Other (specify): _____

3. **SPOUSAL SUPPORT:** None is awarded. It is forever barred; **OR** Shall be paid pursuant to a Uniform Spousal Support Order, which is incorporated by reference.

The insured party is responsible for notifying the insurance company of this Order. This Order shall not prevent or affect beneficiary changes made after this date.

11. **RETIREMENT BENEFITS:** Unless specifically provided in this Judgment, each party shall have their pension, profit sharing, or retirement benefits, free of any claim by the other party.

12. **IMPLEMENTATION:** Each party shall cooperate by signing any documents necessary to carry out the terms of this Judgment. The Judgment may be recorded or used in lieu of the unsigned document.

13. **RETENTION OF JURISDICTION:** the Court retains jurisdiction to interpret and enforce the provisions of this Judgment.

14. **EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Judgment is final on the date it is signed by the Judge and filed with the Clerk. This Judgment resolves the last pending claim in this case and closes the case, except to the extent jurisdiction is retained by law.
